To meet the community's requirement for public art as part of all new private construction, a supermarket company commissioned and installed two southwest-themed murals in their new store.

"We were responsible for all the architectural and electrical components of the new store," explained Lockett-Farley electrical engineer Michael Vena. "Part of that effort included creating a lighting design for the 32' x 8' mural on one wall of the store."

"We needed a design that blended with the fluorescent lighting used throughout the store. It also had to focus illumination only on the mural, with no spill light. Based on an evaluation of the latest in lighting technology and previous positive experience with the company's products, I selected the Williams XT flexible lighting system with 54-watt T5HO fluorescent lamps for the project."

The XT system is a family of rail-mounted modular luminaires that lets the designer create beautiful, flexible, functional lighting systems with plug-and-play convenience. Four linear shapes compliment design themes from traditional to high tech.
